

# THE HOLY SPIRIT'S P.A.C.T



## THEOLOGICAL QUESTION

Who is the Holy Spirit, and what does He do?

## BIG IDEA

The Holy Spirit is God. The Holy Spirit is not an impersonal force, He is a Person. The Holy Spirit is living inside all Christians.

## SCRIPTURE USED

**John 14:25-27:** *I am telling you these things now while I am still with you. But when the Father sends the Advocate as my representative—that is, the Holy Spirit—he will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I have told you. “I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don’t be troubled or afraid.*

**John 16:7-11:** *But in fact, it is best for you that I go away, because if I don’t, the Advocate won’t come. If I do go away, then I will send him to you. And when he comes, he will convict the world of its sin, and of God’s righteousness, and of the coming judgment. The world’s sin is that it refuses to believe in me. Righteousness is available because I go to the Father, and you will see me no more. Judgment will come because the ruler of this world has already been judged.*

**Galatians 5:22-23:** *But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things!*

## OPENER

**Leader’s Note:** If you have more than 6-8 people in your group, consider doubling everything from the supplies needed to the “assigned roles” so that more students have an active part in the illustration.

For the opener you will need:

- Any kind of building blocks (a deck of cards may also be used)
- A note card to read with the “instructions on it”
- Four students to play the roles of: Builder, Helper, Encourager, Advocate
